Program Descriptions for July 2010

Open Programs for Parents, Caregivers, and their Children

Babies in Playland – Ages 0 to 18 months

Parents/caregivers and babies participate together in early learning activities that help to stimulate cognitive, physical and social development. Come meet and connect with other new parents! Information on nutrition and early childhood development will be available.

Family Time – Ages 0 to 6 years

Family Time is for parents and caregivers and their children to meet others and play interactively in an early learning environment. The focus is on promoting positive child development experiences. The program includes; arts and crafts, music, pre-reading, and math concepts.

Infant Action – Ages 3 months to 12 months

This program focuses on developing your infant's large motor skills. A variety of equipment, action songs and rhymes are used to promote this development. *Limited Spaces.*

Creative Movement – Ages 0 to 6 years

The Creative Movement program offers a variety of activities such as finger plays, songs, musical games and movement. This program fosters development in listening skills, auditory awareness, language development and both large and fine motor skills.

Tot Stop – Ages 18 months up to 36 months

This program focuses on toddler development through play. Parents and caregivers engage in activities with their children including, arts and crafts, sensory activities, songs and rhymes. A story and music circle concludes the program.

Me and Dad – Ages 0 to 6 years (Dads only program)

This program is for dad, uncles and grandpas to play interactively with their children. The program includes activities such as arts and crafts, music and movement and focuses on science and discovery.

Let's Create – Ages 18 months to 6 years

In this program children are given the opportunity, through a variety of materials to explore their creative and imaginary skills. Children learn basic concepts and are able to practice their fine motor skills.

Open Door – Ages 0 to 6 years

Come and explore our centre and the many services and resources available to you. Families are welcome to come in and play with their children when regular programs are not being offered.

****Cooking to Learn**** (for parents/caregivers and their children 3-6 years) *Individual Sessions*

This program provides children with a hands-on practical way to develop 'readiness skills' such as vocabulary and language development, understanding of numbers and letters, and development of small muscle coordination. Children will learn basic concepts of good nutrition as they enjoy preparing nutritious foods.
