

Infant to Toddler	
<p>Mornings in Motion - Mondays 18-36 months/Thursdays 0-18 months We will get some exercise and have some fun with a brisk walk through the Mall. This part of the program is suitable for parents/caregivers with children in strollers. After, please join us for Songs & Stories. Please see the day for your child's age.</p>	<p>Babies in Playland - Ages 0 to 18 months Focusing on early development through social and interactive play, this program will include creative, sensory activities, songs and rhymes, motor skills and information for parents/caregivers on infant development and care.</p>
Toddler to Pre-school	
<p>Tot Stop - Ages 18 to 36 months This program focuses on toddlers' development through play. The program includes arts and crafts, sensory activities, songs and rhymes.</p>	<p>Creative Movement - Ages 2 1/2 to 6 years Fun for everyone! We will sing, dance, and play games. The Rainbow Fun program will be incorporated into the circle time.</p>
<p>Story Time with the Librarian - Ages 2 to 5 years Librarian Diana Olford will join us for a Story Time circle to help promote language and literacy skills. Afterwards, she will be available to answer questions about the library and help families to get their own Library Card.</p>	<p>Let's Create - Ages 2 to 6 years This program will encourage children to explore their creative and imaginary skills. Children will have the opportunity to make choices about what to make and how to make it.</p>

<p>Infant Parent-Child Mother Goose - Parents/Caregivers and Infants 0-12 months This 6-week interactive program is parents/caregivers and their babies to learn and enjoy the power of using rhymes, songs, and stories.</p>	<p>Ready for School - Parents/Caregivers and Children starting school Children will do Kindergarten activities while parents/caregivers will get information about what to expect and how they can help their child get ready for school.</p>
<p>Baby Food Basics - Parents/Caregivers of Infants 0-12 months Presented by Food Share, this program will demonstrate techniques for making your own baby food, proper storage and how to adapt the family's meals for baby.</p>	<p>Fun with Numbers Pre-registered - Parents/Caregivers and Children 3-6 years This 4-week interactive program focuses on enhancing children's math skills. Activities include sorting, seriation and number recognition.</p>
<p>Peer Nutrition French/Creole - Parents/Caregivers of Children 0-6 years This six-week workshop presented by the Public Health Nurse in French and Creole focuses on sharing ideas for food preparation and healthy eating for the family.
